- 187. As set forth above, all defendants knew of and consciously disregarded an excessive risk to Plaintiff's health and safety.
- 188. All defendants failed to report the abusive conduct of the defendant police officers to supervisors or other authorities.
- 189. The City and NYPD, their agents, servants and employees, failed to investigate, sanction and/or discipline any of the defendant police officers for their aforesaid unlawful conduct.
- 190. That due to said defendants' failures to protect the plaintiff, he suffered severe and serious physical, psychological and emotional injuries.
- 191. As a result of the foregoing, Plaintiff is entitled to compensatory damages, punitive damages against the individual defendants, and attorney's fees, costs, expert's fees, and disbursements.

TWELFTH CLAIM FOR RELIEF UNDER NEW YORK STATE LAW: PRIMA FACIE TORT

- 192. Plaintiff repeats, reiterates and realleges each and every allegation of paragraphs "1" through "191" inclusive, of this Complaint, as if same were fully set forth herein at length.
- 193. The aforesaid conduct of the defendants, their agents, servants and employees, as well as their delay and failures to act, caused harm to be inflicted upon the plaintiff out of disinterested malevolence and were the proximate cause of the injuries and damages suffered by the plaintiff.
- 194. As a result of the foregoing, Plaintiff suffered severe and serious physical, psychological and emotional injuries.

195. As a result of the foregoing, Plaintiff is entitled to compensatory damages, punitive damages against the individual defendants, and attorney's fees, costs, expert's fees, and disbursements.

JURY DEMAND

196. Plaintiff hereby demands a trial by jury of all issues in this matter.

RELIEF

WHEREFORE, the plaintiff requests the following relief jointly and severally as against all of the defendants:

- 1. An award of compensatory damages in an amount to be determined at trial;
- An award of punitive damages against the non-municipal defendant(s) in an amount to be determined at trial;
 - An award of attorney's fees, expert's fees, costs and disbursements; and
 - Such other and further relief as this Court deems just and proper.
